




As a philosopher, Diogenes was taken surprising seriously, despite his shock tactics. He apparently proved to the satisfaction of the Stoics who came after him that happiness has nothing whatever to do with a person's material circumstances, and they claimed him to be a "sophos" or wise man. An exile and an outcast, a man with no social identity, Diogenes


certainly made a mark on his contemporaries, and his story continues to fascinate students


